General Instructions

Label each sample with patient's name, date of birth, and collection date & time.

- Tumor samples may be provided as frozen tissue or FFPE blocks/slides.
- Saliva samples should be collected using the kit provided.

Tumor Sample Collection

FROZEN TUMOR TISSUE

- Collect a minimum of 100 milligrams of tumor tissue.
- Place sample in a sealed and LABELED tube(s).
- Ship sample for "overnight" delivery (on dry ice if shipping from international locations).
- Use a courier service to ensure samples remain frozen throughout transport.

FORMALIN-FIXED PARAFFIN EMBEDDED TISSUE

SLIDES

- Label ALL slides with pathology accession number.
- Place slides in a plastic slide shipping container then within a bubble-wrapped/insulated mailer:
 - One (1) H&E stained, cover-slipped slide
 - Minimum 12 15 unstained slides; NOT cover slipped (Analysis of less than 10 slides may be possible. Contact us to discuss.)
 - Fresh cut and air-dried
 - 5 10-micron thickness is optimal
 - On "+" charged slides

BLOCKS

- Place block(s) in a plastic bag and label with pathology accessioning number.
- Place block(s) and one cold pack in a Styrofoam container.
- Place Styrofoam container in a box.
- Securely close the box.

Normal Sample Collection

SALIVA SAMPLE(S)

- · Use the Oragene-DNA kit.
 - Two (2) milliliters is sufficient for analysis.
- Samples may be stored for 1 year at room temp.
- · Refer to instructions in kit provided.

BLOOD SAMPLE(S)

- Draw 5 10 milliliters of venous blood draw per tube.
 - Use K2EDTA lavender-top tube(s).
- Gently rock tubes back-and-forth to mix blood and preservatives.
- Do NOT spin the blood tube(s).
- Do NOT freeze blood tube(s) unless they will be stored for more than one (1) month.
 - Samples may be stored at 4°C for less than 1 month.
 - Sample storage of more than 1 month should be frozen at -20°C first, then transferred to a -80°C freezer.
- Wrap tubes in absorbent paper towel and place within a biohazard bag.
- Place biohazard bag in a foam container.
- Deliver samples overnight at room temperature.

Samples must be shipped for arrival at PGDx Monday through Saturday.

Shipping Instructions

- 1. Be sure ALL samples are labeled with patient's name, date of birth, and collection date & time.
- 2. Samples must be shipped for arrival at PGDx on Monday through Saturday.
